
- Regardless of Career Direction Possessing Technology & Math Skills is No Longer an Option

STEM is the Right Choice!

- Demand for 4-yr graduates
 - 2.5 entry-level job postings for each STEM grad
 - 1.1 postings for non-STEM fields
- Salary
 - STEM fields were top 10 degrees with highest median earnings in 2013
- Challenge & impact
 - Requires creativity and critical thinking skills to solve real world problems
 - Consistently ranked top for job satisfaction











STEM Opportunities in CNY

- 100s of CNY technical employers
- NY companies have more STEM jobs than we can fill!
- Cost of living lower in CNY
 - Silicon Valley = 49% higher
 - D.C. = 40.5% higher
- Average salary of entry engineer
 - Silicon Valley = only 25% higher
 - D.C. = only 16.6% higher
 - Syracuse cost of living = 11 pts below national average
- CNY offers great life/work balance!
