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
PREPARING STUDENTS FOR 21st CENTURY

ARE COLLEGE COSTS GETTING **OUT OF REACH?** The average student changes majors four times and spends 5.5 years as an undergraduate student. Of college graduates, over half are unemployed or in non-degree jobs, all with a heavy debt load -- six figures, sometimes. Does the cost of college outweigh the benefits? Can costs be reduced?

Those are questions posed in the documentary film "Ivory Tower," which our partner John Decker, of College Assistance Plus and CollegeOnTrack, screened recently at the Palace Theatre in Syracuse.
